Central LHIN Joins Hospice Vaughan Groundbreaking

Planning for enhanced Palliative Care Services in Western York Region in 2019

Central LHIN is pleased to confirm that construction on the new Hospice Vaughan. A groundbreaking ceremony was held on April 27. Once completed, this new 25,000 square foot facility will include a 10-bed residential hospice, visiting hospice services, and family support and bereavement services. It will also include a community hub for research, education and knowledge transfer on palliative care best practices.

The Central LHIN is working with Hospice Vaughan as well as several other providers to increase palliative care education, training services. An important contributor to the strategy is increasing residential hospice beds from 17 beds in 2017 to 52 beds by 2020.
